## Marietta Street and Centennial Olympic Park Drive Streetscape Project

### PROJECT GOAL

An attractive, walkable sidewalk environment including the following components:

**1. High Quality Sidewalk Surface:**

*Good condition, smooth walking surface, unobstructed passage, consistent material, easy to maintain, repair, patch and replace*

Concrete only – exploring finishes (broom vs. smooth) and scoring patterns.

**2. Green Streets:**

*Tree canopy, ground plane and hanging baskets.*

In-fill street trees where missing, replace un-healthy trees (particularly in medians), add hanging baskets where missing, but most importantly add in-ground planters with constant green cover and seasonal color and where not feasible as above ground planter “pots”

**3. Lighting:**

*Logical, consistent spacing, ample light that is not over bright or glaring*

Repair, refurbish and in-fill CODA “Atlanta Light” type A and C fixtures. Remove Cobra Head lights. Overall regularization of light and pole spacing.

**4. Safe, comfortable crossings:**

*ADA-compliant, accessible ramps, visible, well-marked crosswalks, signal lights are coordinated, no obstructions*

GDOT and City of Atlanta standards and guidelines

**5. Furnishings:**

*Well organized and in good repair, out of clear path, consistent treatment, contribute to a creative, memorable, unique public space.*

Bus shelter treatment (benches/signage), effort to implement “pilot” newspaper condos, additional trash cans

**6. Operations:**

*Improved drainage, well marked loading zones and dedicated bus stop areas, consistent and continuous vehicle lanes*

Coordinate milling and re-paving with City of Atlanta during project construction, but through a separate funding source and contract.
