With 9 MARTA Rail Stations and over 300 MARTA Bus Stops Downtown, it is easy to get to and around Downtown with transit. By using transit, you don't have to waste your time sitting in traffic. You can spend your commute reading, listening to music, napping, or getting a bit of work done, while saving money along the way.

How to Ride MARTA

MARTA is great way to get to and around Downtown! Visit [MARTA's website](#) to learn about the system. The rail runs north to south and east to west, and there are four lines (red, gold, blue, and green). A few tips:

- 1 Use [MARTA Plan A Trip](#) feature to find the best route to your destination.
- 2 Park and ride - free daily parking is available at most MARTA Rail Stations. For \$5 or \$8, you can also take advantage of overnight parking at nine stations. Leave your car at designated stations and ride the train to your destination, easy breezy!

How to Use Breeze Card

MARTA fare is \$2.50 for a one-way trip (both for bus and train). In addition to single trip fare, you can also purchase a MARTA pass which may be a cheaper option if you plan to ride MARTA multiple times on one day. MARTA offers 1, 2, 3, 4, 7 and 30 day passes. Use [MARTA Breeze Card](#) if you are riding MARTA for more than one day. MARTA Breeze Card is a long-term use card. It allows you to load various and multiple fare products and it can be registered for Balance Protection. The cost of the Breeze Card is \$2.00. You can purchase your Breeze Card online, at MARTA RideStores (at Airport Station and Five Points Station) and at Breeze vending machines.



How to Transfer

Every Breeze Card or ticket comes with up to four transfers (within 3-hour period). To transfer from a train to a bus, make sure to tap your Breeze Card to exit the station. If you're transferring from bus to a train, remember to pay the bus fare with a Breeze Card, not cash.

Bringing Your Bike on MARTA?

No problem, [MARTA is bike-friendly](#). Every bus has storage racks and every train has plenty of room for both you and your bike. A few tips:

- 1 Use [ATL Transit Trip Planner](#) to help you plan your bike ride and transit trip
- 2 MARTA stations offer free bike storage – just bring a lock and find an open spot for your bike.
- 3 If you're taking a MARTA bus, make sure the bus driver sees you before trying to place your bike on the front rack and remember to always hook the safety bar over your bike.
- 4 To park your bike in Downtown, browse our [interactive bike racks map](#).
- 5 Don't have a bike? Share a bike! Browse our [interactive bike share map](#).
