### MEMORANDUM

**Re: Notice of Amplified Sound and Fairlie-Poplar Street Closures, October 17 – October 23, 2014**

To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify residents and business owners within the Fairlie-Poplar district about *Elevate Atlanta*; an annual public art festival held from October 17-23, 2014. *Elevate* is a public art project produced by the City of Atlanta, Mayor's Office of Cultural Affairs, with goals to heighten the visual experience and support for community involvement and economic stability in Downtown Atlanta.

Street closures will be enforced for 3 projects. **Friday, October 17<sup>th</sup>** is *Elevate's* opening night, and streets surrounding the Fairlie-Poplar intersection at Fairlie Street, between Walton and Lucky Street, as well as Poplar Street, between Cone and Forsyth Street, will be closed to vehicular traffic from **12:00 pm to 12:00 am**.

**On Friday, October 17<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>**, Fairlie Street, between Walton and Marietta Street will be closed from **12:00 pm – 12:00 am**.

In addition, some projects that require amplified sound will be audible within the Fairlie-Poplar district on various days during *Elevate* week.
